A petition has been organised to be handed to the Legislative Member of Parliament. Keith has a copy of the petition for you to sign.

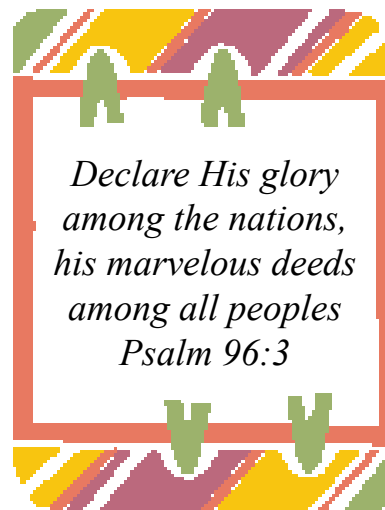
