Sunday Morning 9:30am

The 9:30am Family Service appeals to people who prefer a more informal, family friendly atmosphere. It is an interactive service featuring worship music with modern rock/pop feel, a special spot for children, interviews and opportunities to ask questions following the Bible talk. A crèche and children's program run concurrently.

Sunday Service 6:00pm

Most people who come to the Sunday evening service are in their 20's and 30's but all ages are welcome. We learn together from the Bible, pray, catch up with friends and meet new people. Our evening often includes testimony, drama and video to further bring home the teaching about Jesus and help people to see the difference he makes in our lives.



Home Groups

Apart from Sundays most members our community meet in home group. In home groups people get to know each other, study the Bible, pray and help each other out.

Playtime

We run a Playgroup that provides play activities and friendship for parents. Playtime meets Thursdays 10am-12pm during term. Come for coffee, chat, kid's play, craft, singing and book reading.

BE Scene - youth group

This group is for year 7-12 students and meets from 6:30 to 8:30 on Friday nights. Activities include table tennis, hachy sack, discussion, talks and studies.

Men's Prayer triplets
